




TPI Composites, Inc. (TPI) 2019 ESG Report Sustainable Development Goals (SDG) Supplement

This provides significant reductions in greenhouse gas emissions and improvements in air pollution which contributes to a healthier environment and healthier lives.</p> <p>In 2019, TPI accounted for approximately 18% of all sold onshore wind blades on a MW-basis globally, with more than 9,500 blades sold. Additionally, over the last 5 years, the wind blades TPI sold have the potential to reduce more than 980 million metric tons of CO₂ over their average 20-year life span.</p>
 <p>8 DECENT WORK AND ECONOMIC GROWTH</p>	<p>Safety is our most important core value. We strongly believe that every associate should return at the end of their shift to their families in the same healthy condition in which they showed up for work at the beginning of their shift. Over the last four years we have reduced our recordable incident rate by 82% and our lost time incident rate by 78% and are well below the industry standard.</p> <p>We are proud to support our direct associates and the communities in which we operate. For every associate employed in manufacturing facilities, approximately 1.6 additional jobs are created in the region. Therefore, for our approximately 13,300 associates directly employed at TPI at year-end 2019, we estimate that we support a further 21,280 employment opportunities for a total of 34,580 jobs globally.</p>

 	<p>We have a history of innovation in advanced composite technologies and continue to address increasing physical dimensions, demanding technical specifications and strict quality control requirements for our customers' most advanced wind blades. We also leverage our history of innovation to supply unique, high-strength, lightweight and durable composite product solutions to support the electrification of the transportation market.</p>
	<p>Operational excellence is one of TPI's core values and we strive for continuous improvements in our operations. We first reduce the amount of waste that we produce and then divert our waste generated from landfills, through recycling and energy recovery. In 2019, approximately 35.8% of our waste produced was recycled or used in energy recovery.</p>
	<p>Integrity is one of TPI's core values and we follow the highest of ethical standards, observing all laws and regulations and their spirit everywhere we do business. TPI's Code of Conduct and our separate Anti-Corruption Policy educate associates on anti-corruption practices and expressly prohibits direct and indirect payments that violate applicable anti-corruption laws. TPI's associates receive annual training on both the Code and the Anti-Corruption Policy and are available in their local language.</p>
